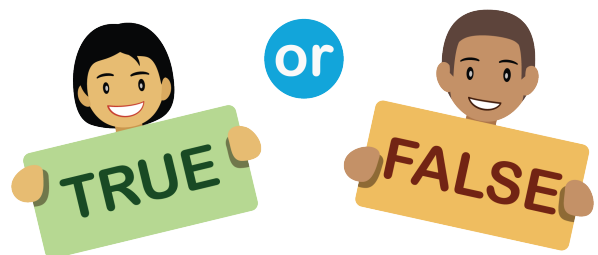
Decide if each statement is true or false.

- $10 + 10 + 10 = 3$



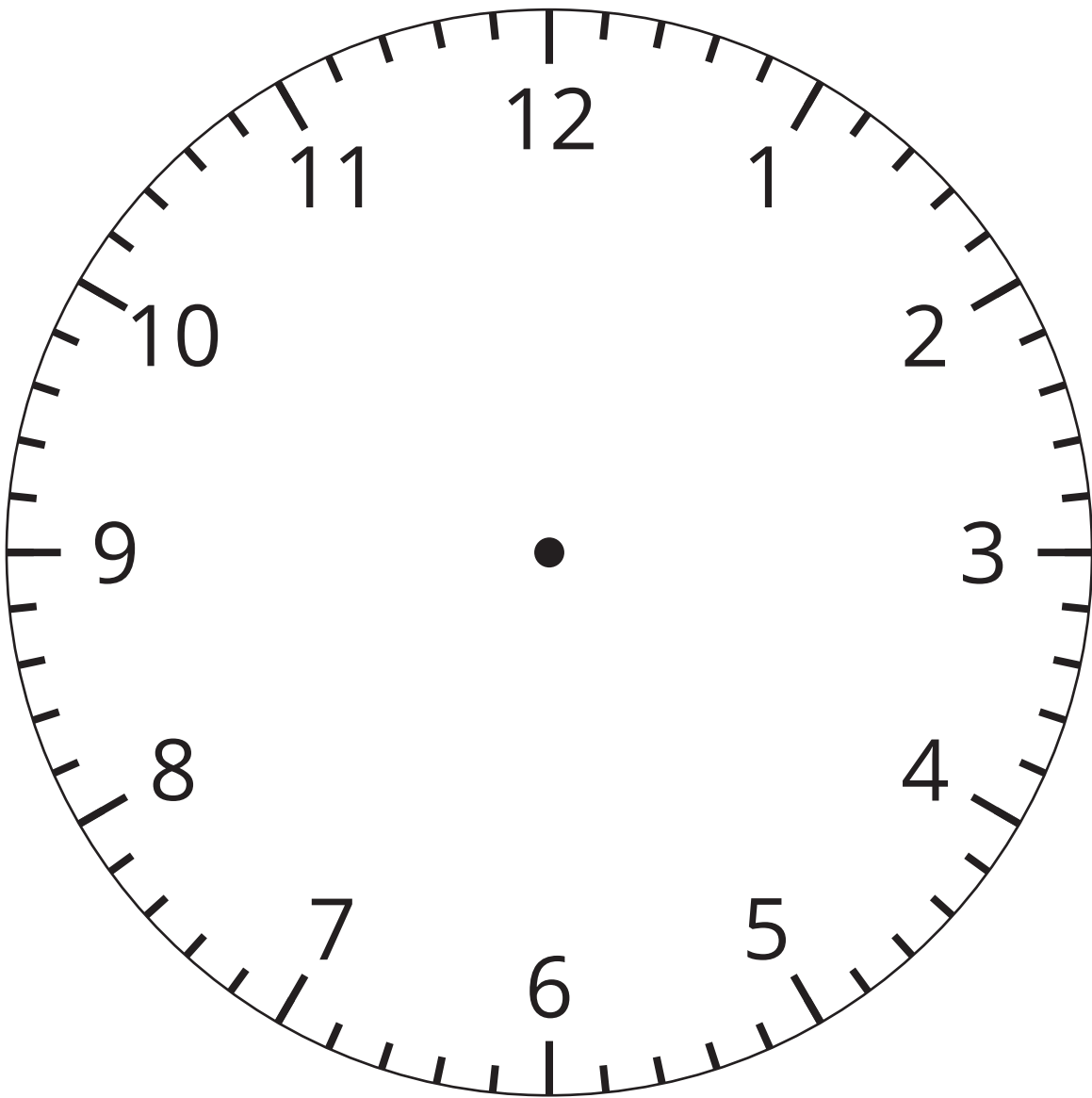

Count the Minutes

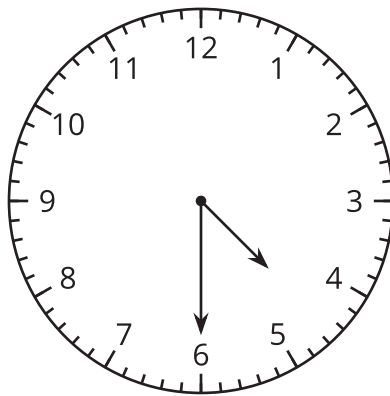
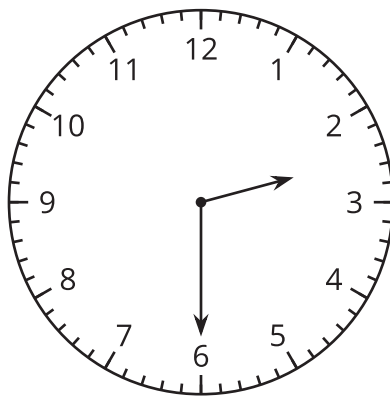
Start at 12.

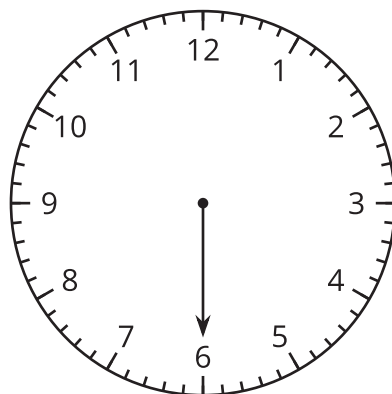
3. For each clock, draw the hour hand and write the time.
