



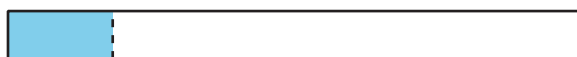
# Share More Sandwiches

Jada’s family made sandwiches to share equally at a picnic. Complete the table to show how much sandwich each person gets.

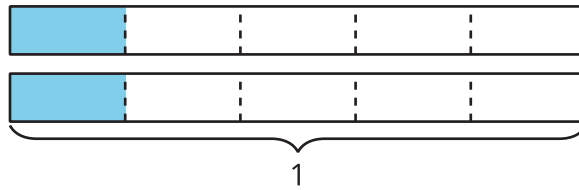
