Create a line plot to represent the measurement data you collected. You will display and share your line plot with your class later.

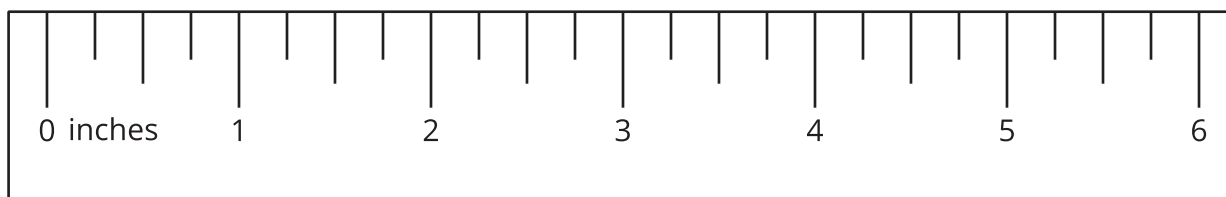
You can use the blank number line here for your draft. Think about:
