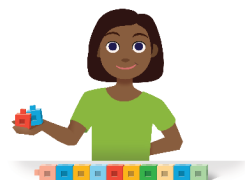


Directions:

- Partner B: Record the answer to complete the equation.
- Switch roles and repeat.



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
