

Giving Bonuses



Task Statement 1

A project at a large company was very successful, and the company made more money than expected as a result. Your boss has given you the task of coming up with different methods to distribute bonuses to the 5 employees who directly worked on the project. There is a total of \$8,000 to distribute.
