



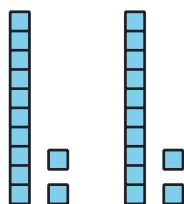
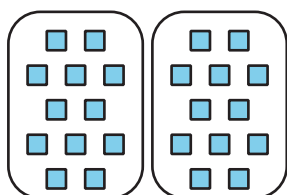
Ways to Represent Multiplication of Teen Numbers

What do you notice? What do you wonder?

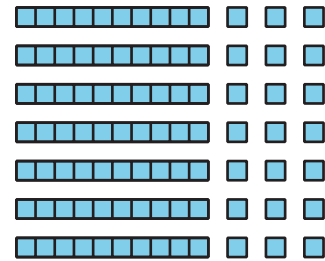


Activity 1

Do you agree or disagree? Explain your reasoning.



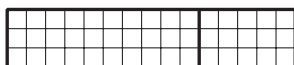
2. Use Tyler's method to find the value of 3×14 . Explain or show your reasoning.

Andre, Clare, and Diego represented the same expression in different ways

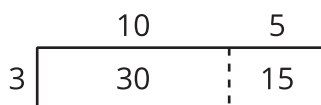
Andre
