Si cada boleto cuesta \$20, el costo total es $45 \times 20 = 900$.

\$18 es \$2 menos que \$20, entonces a de 45×20 (900) se le resta 45×2 (90).

La diferencia es 810.

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B Kiran

$$10 \times 18 = 180$$

$$20 \times 18 = 360$$

$$40 \times 18 = 720$$

$$5 \times 18 = 90$$

$$\begin{aligned} 45 \times 18 &= (40 \times 18) + (5 \times 18) \\ &= 720 + 90 \\ &= 810 \end{aligned}$$

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C Han

100 boletos cuestan \$1,800.

50 boletos cuestan la mitad de \$1,800,
que es \$900.

45 boletos es menos que 50 boletos, así
que tendrán suficiente dinero.

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D Tyler

$$18 = 9 \times 2$$

$$2 \times 45 = 90$$

$$\begin{aligned} 18 \times 45 &= 9 \times 2 \times 45 \\ &= 9 \times 90 \\ &= 810 \end{aligned}$$
