- Remove the cards that show 10 and set aside. Shuffle the cards and place them facedown in a stack.
- Pick a card. Write that number as a digit in one of your blanks for Round 1.

- Repeat until each partner has a 6-digit number.
- Write a comparison using $>$, $<$, or $=$.
- The partner with the greater 6-digit number wins the round.
