2. Write your own expression and matching diagram. Be prepared to explain your reasoning.

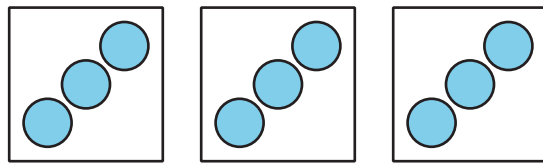
